## Law/Gospel

## The Temptation of Jesus

Matthew 4:1–11

**J**esus was led into the wilderness by the Holy Spirit. There, He would be tempted by the devil.

Three times the devil tried to cause Jesus to sin. Each time Jesus fends off the devil’s temptations, He does so using the powerful Word of God.

## Family Faith Talk

“Lead us not into temptation . . .” Jesus beat the devil for us. Only Jesus forgives our sins, and only Jesus can empower us to say no to sin. Through His Word, He helps us resist the devil’s temptations and offers forgiveness when we fail. Begin to learn God’s Word by heart. Start by learning your favorite verses. Act out the words, or sing them to a favorite tune. Write the passage on a sticky note, and practice it in the car at red lights. Even the youngest children can memorize, and you’ll love seeing them recall it later when they need it most!

## Prayer

Lord Jesus, You are stronger than anything or anyone. You proved that when You resisted the devil’s temptations and when You rose from the dead to give us life forever. Lead us, Lord, to read and study Your Word and to know it well. Give us Your Word and Your strength to resist the temptations of the devil, the world, and our sinful selves.
